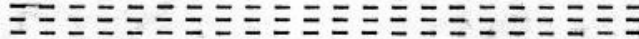

Two NASA films, "Universe on a Scratchpad" and "Assignment: Shoot the Moon" are scheduled for this meeting. "Universe on a Scratchpad" is a study of modern day astrophysicists and their methods of studying the universe. "Assignment: Shoot the Moon" summarizes the results of the Ranger, Surveyor and Lunar Orbiter programs.
